

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Closing Date: All entries must be received by Wednesday 21 April. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Entries Secretary, subject to a £5.00 supplement.
2. Withdrawals: To Mrs K Smith, Foxhill Farm, Eydon, Daventry, Northants NN11 3QB. Tel. 01295 760230 by Wednesday 21 April. There will be no refund of entry fees after this date.
3. Starting times will be allocated for all classes. Go to www.foxhill-farm.com or telephone Foxhill Farm on 01295 760230 on Friday 23 April between 6pm and 8pm.
4. The course will be open for inspection on Saturday 24 April from 2pm.
5. Competitor briefings on Optimum Time at 3pm and 5pm in the Sponsors' Tent.
6. No wrist or stop watches to be worn while competing on the course.
7. Competitors must wear back protectors, crash hats to BSI standard and medical armbands.
8. All riders must wear a hat at all times when riding.
9. No horse/pony to compete more than once in any one class.
10. Junior riders to be aged 8 years or over.
11. When not competing riders must ride in the designated practice areas and only jump flagged fences.
12. Eliminated riders may continue at the discretion of the course officials.
13. Veterinary cover will be provided on the day, all fees to be met by the individual.
14. All dogs to be kept on leads.
15. Only official vehicles will be allowed on the course.
16. Please take all your litter home with you.
17. The organisers reserve the right to alter, amend or cancel any class and to refuse any entry for any reason what so ever.
18. The organising committee of the Grafton Hunt will not accept any liability whatsoever for any injury, accident, illness or damage to any horse, rider, spectator, or any other person or property.
19. All competitors will agree to abide by the rules of the competition.

Classes 1, 2 and 4 incorporate qualifiers for the Finals of the **BHS Cross Country Championships 2010**. In Class 1 the TWO highest placed pairs and in Classes 2 and 4 the TWO highest placed riders per class who are BHS Gold Members ON THE DAY OF THE QUALIFIER will qualify for the Final. In the event of a combination of horse/pony and rider already having qualified, the qualification will pass to the next competitor. YOU MUST FILL IN YOUR BHS MEMBERSHIP ON THE ENTRY FORM, and we recommend you carry your membership card on the day. Non-members may enter qualifying classes but will not be eligible to qualify. Horses registered for British Eventing Horse Trials in 2010 are NOT eligible to qualify for the Finals ('BE Day Tickets' are acceptable). Rules at Qualifiers may differ from those at the Finals. Classes at the finals will be Novice and Pairs (both max 2ft 9ins) and Open (max 3ft 3ins). The Finals will take place in the autumn of 2010 (date to be confirmed) at Eland Lodge Equestrian, Draycott-in-the-Clay, Sudbury, Derbyshire.
